**** THE LEGACY OF JOHN MILNE ****

Superintendent, 1911 - 1956

John Milne was a Scottish immigrant born in 1880. The Milne family came to Albuquerque to seek a tuberculosis cure. Milne became superintendent in 1911 when Albuquerque had 5 schools. Milne had the vision of a future Albuquerque as a large city. His foresight in purchasing thousands of acres of vacant mesa land made today's APS system possible.
